Patient Access Online Service

Patient Access connects you to local health services when you need them most. Book appointments (when the service is available), order repeat prescriptions and discover local health services for you or your family via your mobile or home computer. Sign in with ease using your NHS login.

We are encouraging all patients to sign up for the patient access application. You can sign up for this service by popping into the surgery and completing the online service application form. You will then receive a linkage key and given guidance on how to sign up for the service. You will be asked to provide proof of identification at the time of registering for the service.

The service will give you access to your medical records where you will be able to see any recent medical test results or hospital letters. It will give you the freedom to access your patient records as and when you need to.

Up to date with Immunisations?



In response to the ongoing measles outbreak in London and the recent increase in cases across the Black Country, NHS England has arranged a one-off MMR catch-up clinic for school-age children (Year 1 to Year 11) who have missed one or both doses of the MMR vaccine.

The catch-up clinic will take place at:

Meningitis B Vaccination - Important Information

The Meningitis B vaccination was not rolled out until 2015. This means that **ALL vaccinated children born 2015 onwards** will have received a Meningitis B vaccination if they have been kept up to date with their vaccinations.

Anyone **born before 2015** will **NOT** have had the Meningitis B vaccination.

All school children aged 14yrs-15yrs will be offered the Meningitis ACWY vaccination at school. This invite will be sent directly to **ALL** parents/guardians directly from the school and a consent form for this will have to be completed by the parents/guardians for the child to have the vaccination.

If your child has missed the Meningitis ACWY vaccination at school this can be given up to the age of 25yrs old.

Next of Kin



Next of Kin the named person who will be contacted in case of an emergency on behalf you the patient. You can name anyone as your next of kin as long they are over the age of 18. A next of kin will not have access to any of your medical information without your prior consent. Please contact the surgery if you would like to add a named next of kin to your medical records.

If you would like a nominated person to have access to your medical information on your behalf, you will need to complete a patient access consent form which can be requested from reception.

New Security Door System

You may have noticed the internal door in the waiting room is now automatically locked. This is to ensure both patient and staff safety. If you need to access via the door, you will need to ask at the reception desk.

Please make sure your contact details are kept up to date. If you have recently moved address or changed your phone number, please pop into the surgery to complete a change of details form.
